



## WRYC JUNIOR SAILING PROGRAM 2009



This summer's sailing program will consist of two one-week Opti Kids programs for 8 year olds and over, in addition to our usual two-week sessions for kids at least 10 years of age. The four regular sessions each run for two weeks, Monday - Thursday from 9 a.m. to 5 p.m., rain or shine. It is very important that *sailors stay for the entire day* to prevent their sailing partner from being stranded without a skipper or crew. Life jackets and footwear for on and off the water are mandatory. A swim test is given on the first day of the session. Each participant is expected to be able to swim 50 meters and tread water or float for several minutes. In order to promote a more balanced and safe learning experience, each Opti session is limited to 10 sailors. All campers must be at least 8 years of age.

A potluck banquet and awards ceremony is held on the second Thursday of each regular session. A parent (or group of parents) is needed for each session to coordinate this. Please look for the sign-up sheet on the first day of camp and indicate how you may help.

Participants are encouraged to provide their own boats. This year there will be a \$50 discount on the fee listed below if you provide your own boat. The boat discount can be used for up to two sailors in the same family. The boat must be present for the entire camp session, in good working order, and used by the sailors during the session. For the discount to apply, the boat must be an Opti, Laser or 420.

To ensure that all WRYC members have an equal opportunity to participate, for the month of February 2009 applications will be taken only from members' children and grandchildren, who may sign up for any session(s). After March 1, 2009, all remaining slots will be available to anyone on a "first come, first served" basis. If there are more applications for a session than can be accommodated, slots will be filled based on the earliest postmark. Applications *must* be mailed and have the proper deposit amount included in order for the child to be added to the session roster. No exceptions, due to the increased number of applications received this past year. Please fill out a separate application for each child, and for each session (if multiple sessions are desired).

Member means a member in good standing (you paid your 2009 dues). Grandchildren, to receive the lower fee, may not be local residents (this requirement may be waived by the WRYC board depending on circumstances).
